

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 06-27-2020

Passed 6-16-, 2020

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO MUTUAL POLICE AID AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES TO MUTUALLY OBTAIN AND PROVIDE ADDITIONAL POLICE PROTECTION AND RELATED SUPPORT IN TIMES OF EMERGENCY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department in times of emergency have insufficient equipment or personnel to adequately protect the citizens of the City of Circleville and their property; and

**WHEREAS**, other municipalities within Pickaway and its adjoining counties are willing to provide additional police protection and related support in times of emergency at no cost to the city in exchange for a mutual agreement by the City of Circleville to provide such additional police protection and related support to their municipalities when needed; and

**WHEREAS**, Sections 311.07, 311.29, 737.04 and 737.041 of the Ohio Revised Code specifically authorizes political subdivisions and local governmental units to enter into mutual police aid agreements; and

**WHEREAS**, the entering into such mutual aid agreements is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Circleville, and the same ought to be done.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio, as follows:

**SECTION I.** That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into mutual police aid agreements with other municipalities within Pickaway and its adjoining counties to mutually obtain and provide additional police protection and related support in times of emergency in accordance with the terms and conditions as set forth in the Mutual Aid Agreement attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A," and incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION II.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need to ensure adequate police protection and support to the citizens of the City of Circleville at all times, so that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
