Circleville City Council convened on Tuesday January 19, 2021 at 7:00 pm. ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

An Ordinance Amending Section 351.99 Of The Codified Ordinances Of The City Of Circleville To Provide Civil Penalties For Certain Parking Infractions And Declaring An Emergency. Hedges stated this was reviewed in the Judicial Cmte mtg. and was recommended for passage. Hedges stated this change the structure of fines from a criminal violation to a civil violation. Klitzka motioned to suspend the rules. Theis seconded. Roll call (7 Yeas – 0 Nays). Rules are Suspended. Hallinin motioned for passage. Klitzka seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Ordinance passes and was assigned #01-02-2021.

An Ordinance Implementing A Chapter 357 To The Codified Ordinances Of City Of Circleville To Establish A Parking Violations Bureau and Provide Procedures For The Processing Of Parking Infractions And Declaring An Emergency. Hedges stated this was reviewed in the Judicial Cmte with a recommendation for passage. Hedges stated this is establishing a parking violation bureau. Klitzka motioned to suspend the rules. Keller seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas – 0 Nays) Rules are Suspended. Blanton motioned for passage. Theis seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas -0 Nays). Ordinance passes and was assigned #01-03-2021.

NEW BUSINESS

Hedges motioned to reappoint Fr. David Getreu to the Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA), this is a five-year term. Theis seconded. Voice vote. Motion carried.

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Brian S. Stewart | State Representative (OH-78) stated that he would like to keep improvements to the county and the city has a whole going for the future with funding from the capital budget. Stewart stated that as a Pickaway County Commissioner he honored the commitment of \$50,000 to help replace the Everts Center HVAC system.

Hallinin motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 pm, seconded by Theis. Motion carried.
