

SPECIAL CIRCLEVILLE CITY COUNCIL

Special Circleville City Council convened in Council Chambers Tuesday, January 25, 2022, at 6:50 pm. Members present: Council President Barry Keller; Tom Duvall, At Large; Michelle Blanton, At Large; Katie Logan Hedges, At Large; Jeff Hallinin, First Ward; Caryn Koch-Esterline, Second Ward; Todd Brady, Third Ward; Sheri Theis, Fourth Ward; and Linda Chancey, Clerk. Guest present: Mayor Don McIlroy.

President Keller called the meeting to order at 6:50 pm. Roll call. All Present.

Hedges motioned to dismiss agenda Items # 2 thru 9, seconded by Theis. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE FOR SECOND READING

An Ordinance To Submit To The Electors Of The City Of Circleville The Question Of Whether Or Not To Effect An Opt-Out Electric Aggregation Program Pursuant To Section 4928.20 Of The Ohio Revised Code, Directing The County Board Of Elections To Submit A Ballot Question To The Electors And Declaring An Emergency. Keller refreshed Council members on the status of this ordinance. The ordinance was first reviewed in the Cmte Of Whole meeting, then passed upon third reading at the December 30, 2021, special council meeting. In mid-January the Board Of Elections notified President Pro Tem Theis that ordinance #12-79-2022 was rejected because of insufficient details about the electric aggregation program. At the January 18, 2022 meeting council received the new ordinance and held it for a second reading

Hedges motioned to suspend the rules. Seconded by Brady. Roll call. (7 Yeas – 0 Nays). Rules Are Suspended. Hedges motioned for passage. Seconded by Brady. Roll call. (4 Yeas -Blanton-Brady-Hallinin and Hedges- 3 Nays – Duvall- Esterline and Theis).

Ordinance passes and assigned # 01-03-2022, without the emergency clause.

Duvall motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:58 p.m. Hedges seconded. Motion carried.
