ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

An Ordinance Authorizing The Mayor To Enter Into A Community Reinvestment Area Agreement With Circleville Senior Living, LLC, Pursuant To Ohio Revised Code Chapter 735 And Declaring An Emergency. Hedges stated this was reviewed in the judicial cmte and was recommended for passage. Hedges stated this is from the Lemon Group for Senior Housing on Stoutsville Pike, this project is a \$9.5 million development, for people that are 55 year older.
