

Via Remote Teleconference

Circleville City Council convened a Remote teleconference Public Hearing on Tuesday, April 21, 2020 at 6:45 P.M. The following members called in: David Crawford; President of Council; Michelle Blanton, At Large; Katie Logan Hedges, At Large; Tom Klitzka, At Large; Jeff Hallinin, First Ward; Barry Keller, Second Ward; Todd Brady, Third Ward; Sheri Theis, Fourth Ward and Linda Chancey, Clerk. Guests in that remote teleconference were Mayor Don McIlroy; Service Director; Terry Frazier; Safety Director Tony Chamberlain.

Roll call

Crawford provided a phone number for the public to call into Public Hearing for comments.

The Public Hearing notice was published in the local news media Circleville Herald newspaper on March 20, 2020. There were no phone calls or correspondences regarding this Public Hearing.

Crawford stated the purpose of the Public Hearing is to hear public comments as requested by Planning and Zoning regarding the revisions to the Circleville Zoning Code and the Circleville Zoning Map.

Terry Frazier Service Director explained that in the Circleville Planning and Zoning Code – a request was made to amend Section 1902 “Permitted Uses”. Frazier continued, the City does not allow a single structure or dwelling for the condo community. By amending this section it will allow for multiple single-family home structures or dwellings for single family living.

Crawford stated the Zoning change modification ordinance was viewed in the Judicial Cmte. This will be placed on City Council agenda for May 5, 2020.

The hearing was closed at 6:52 pm.
