VIA REMOTE TELECONFERENCE

Circleville City Council convened on Tuesday April 7, 2020 at 7:00 pm. Some of the EOC functions and conversations are with agencies and performed remotely. Each day a meeting is hosted at 8:30 am and again at 4:00 pm with different departments and agencies in the City and County with a Representative from the State of Ohio for a path going forward. Planning efforts continue with the different agencies for tracking the population with the COVID-19.

The Mayor commented that the level of leadership with the County and City regarding COVID-19 has been great. This gives an overall view in the City and County with these informative meetings. The Mayor continued with City updates with each departments.
