

## CIRCLEVILLE CITY COUNCIL MEETING 4-21-2020

### VIA REMOTE TELECONFERENCE

Circleville City Council convened on Tuesday April 21, 2020 at 7:00 pm. ### ORDINANCE FOR FIRST READING

**An Ordinance Authorizing the Director of Public Service to Enter into A Memorandum of Agreement with The Board Of Park Commissioners of The Pickaway County Park District (PCPD) For The Collaborative Operation And Maintenance Of The Mary Virginia Crites Hannan Park (MVCHP) And Declaring An Emergency.** This is stated this was reviewed in the Strategic Planning Cmte. This authorizes the service director to partner with the City and Board of Park Commissioners with a management plan for the prairie lands and wooded area of this park Terry Frazier explained how the Pickaway County Park District and the City have a collaborative operation and maintenance of the MVHC Park.
