ORDINANCE FOR THIRD READING

The Ordinance Establishing A Procurement and Purchasing Policy for The Governmental and Enterprise Departments of The City of Circleville. Keller stated this was reviewed in the Finance Cmte. This establishes a purchasing policy that is City-wide, all departments. Keller motioned for passage. Brady seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas – 0 Nays). Ordinance passes and assigned #06-23-2020.

ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

An Ordinance Authorizing The Director Of Public Safety To Submit Applications For Any Federal, State Or Local Grant Available To Assist In Covering The Expenses To The City Arising Out Of The Covid-19 Pandemic And Declaring An Emergency. Keller stated this was reviewed in the Finance Cmte. This is to apply for Federal, State or Local grants for expenses related to the Covid -19 Pandemic. Keller motioned to suspend the rules. Theis seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas – 0 Nays). Rules are Suspended. Keller motioned for passage. Brady seconded. Roll call. (7 Years - 0 Nays) Ordinance passes and assigned #06-24-2020.

An Ordinance Amending The Annual Appropriation Ordinance in The Waterworks Improvement and Extension Fund 819 Of The City Of Circleville. Keller stated this was reviewed in the Finance Cmte. This is for the improvements at the water treatment plant. Keller motioned to suspend the rules. Brady seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas – 0 Nays). Rules are Suspended. Keller motioned for passage. Theis seconded. Roll call. (7 Years - 0 Nays.) Ordinance passes and assigned #06-25-2020.

Adopting The Budget of The City of Circleville, Ohio For the Fiscal Year Beginning January 1, 2021 And Submitting the Same To County Auditor. Keller stated this was reviewed in the Finance Cmte and recommended for passage after three (3) readings. This is the proposed 2021 City Budget in the amount of \$24,724,543.30. Keller motioned to hold for a second reading. Blanton seconded. Roll call. (7 Yeas – 0 Nays). Ordinance will be held until June 16th for a second reading.

Hallinin motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:17 pm, seconded by Hedges. Motion carried.
