Circleville City Council convened on Tuesday June 16, 2020 at 7:00 pm. Brady motioned to approve the Public Hearing Tax Budget minutes June 7, 2020, Theis seconded. Motion carried. Klitzka motioned to approve the June 7, 2020 Council minutes, Brady seconded. Motion approved.

ORDINANCE FOR SECOND READING

Adopting The Budget of The City of Circleville, Ohio For the Fiscal Year Beginning January 1, 2021 And Submitting the Same To County Auditor. Keller stated this was reviewed in the Finance Cmte and recommended for passage after three (3) readings. This is the proposed 2021 City Budget in the amount of \$24,724,543.30. Keller motioned to hold for a third reading. Brady seconded. Roll call. (6 Yeas – 0 Nays). Ordinance will be held until July 7th for a third reading.

ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

A Resolution Authorizing The Downtown Business Association Retail Merchants A Division Of The Pickaway County Chambers Of Commerce, To Utilize A Portion Of City Sidewalks, Streets And Alleys For Their Events For 2020 And Declaring An Emergency. Blanton stated this is an annual DBA resolution for the street closings for their events. Blanton motioned to suspend the rules. Klitzka seconded. Rules are suspended. Brady motioned for adoption. Theis seconded. Roll call. (6 Yeas – 0 Nays). Resolution is adopted and assigned #06-26-2020.

An Ordinance Authorizing The Safety Director To Enter Into A Mutual Police Aid Agreements With Other Municipalities To Mutually Obtain And Provide Additional Police Protection And Related Support In Times Of Emergency And Declaring An Emergency. Blanton stated this was reviewed in the Safety Mtg. and was recommended for passage. Safety Director Tony Chamberlain explained if the COVID-19 would spread to the Police dept. what would that do to manning the dept. This will allow the Sheriffs Dept or OSHP to assist the City Police Dept. Blanton motioned to suspend the rules. Brady seconded. Rules are suspended. Brady motioned for passage. Theis seconded. Roll call. (6 Yeas – 0 Nays). Ordinance passes and assigned #06-27-2020.

NEW BUSINESS

Brady motioned to excuse Katie Logan Hedges from tonight's Council Mtg. Hallinin seconded. Motion carried.

Brady motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:24 pm, seconded by Klitzka. Motion carried.
