

CIRCLEVILLE CITY COUNCIL 9-1-2020

Circleville City Council convened on Tuesday September 1, 2020 at 7:00 pm. The following members met at the Mary Virginia Crites Hannan Park - Starkey Pavilion. David Crawford; President of Council; Michelle Blanton, At Large; Katie Logan Hedges, At Large; Tom Klitzka, At Large; Jeff Hallinin, First Ward; Todd Brady, Third Ward; Sheri Theis, Fourth Ward and Linda Chancey, Clerk. ABSENT: Barry Keller, Second Ward. Invited guests Service Director Terry Frazier and City Auditor Gayle Spangler.

President David Crawford called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Crawford invited the public, if they wish, to join with Council for the invocation. Crawford stated the minutes for August 18, 2020 are approved as written.

ORDINANCE FOR FIRST READING

An Ordinance To Amend The Zoning District Of Parcel #A05204200002200, A0520420000100, A0520420000200, A0520420000300 From Downtown Business District (DB) To General Business District (GB). Crawford stated this was reviewed in the Committee of Whole Mtg. with a recommendation for passage. This is a request from Englefield Oil to rezone property located beside the Duke & Duchess Convenience and fuel station on East Main St. They will tear down the current buildings and construct new buildings.

Hedges motioned to suspend the rules. Klitzka seconded. Roll call. (6 Yeas – 0 Nays).

Rules are suspended. Brady motioned for passage. Klitzka seconded. Roll call. (6 Yeas – 1 Nay – Theis). Ordinance passes and assigned #09-47-2020.
