Ordinance No. 04-15 - 2020 Passed 4-21-, 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS OF THE PICKAWAY COUNTY PARK DISTRICT (PCPD) FOR THE COLLABORATIVE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MARY VIRGINIA CRITES HANNAN PARK (MVCHP) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Pickaway County Park District (PCPD) and the City of Circleville (CITY) have multiple outdoor recreational facilities under their authority which require maintenance and improvement so as to preserve and enhance the historic sites, parks, trails and green spaces for the enjoyment and education of present and future inhabitants and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Pickaway County Park District and the CITY understand the value and benefit in working together to operate and manage their outdoor recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the PCPD and CITY are desirous of working collaboratively to more effectively operate and maintain the Mary Virginia Crites Hannan Park and to establish between them a management plan for the prairie and wooded area of this park; and

WHEREAS, to memorialize this joint effort, and the PCPD and CITY desire to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the entering into this Memorandum of Agreement is the best interest of the citizens of the City of Circleville and the same ought to be done.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the Director of Public Service of the City of Circleville is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Board of Park Commissioners of the Pickaway County Park District (PCPD) to work collaboratively with the Board for the operation and maintenance of the Mary Virginia Crites Hannan Park and specifically for the development of a management plan for the prairie and wooded area of this park. This Memorandum of Agreement and management plan shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions as set forth in the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference.

SECTION II. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need for the approval of this Agreement to ensure assistance from the Pickaway County Park District for this upcoming park season, so that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
