

**LEGAL NOTICE
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE FOR RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE

Sealed proposals for Collection and Disposal Service for Residential Solid Waste within the City of Circleville, County of Pickaway, State of Ohio (hereinafter called "the City", will be received by the Department of Public Service, City of Circleville at 104 E. Franklin Street, Circleville, Ohio 43113 until 11:00 a.m. on March 15, 2013 at which time the submissions will be opened and the required qualification documents will be reviewed for completeness.

The City intends to award a contract for the Collection and Disposal of Residential Solid Wastes within the City of Circleville under the terms of a three-year Contract with renewal options.

The purposes for awarding the Contract are to help secure for City residents:

1. Lower cost of monthly trash service by a private contractor;
2. Greater traffic safety by the elimination of multiple packer trucks collecting the same routes on multiple days during the same week;
3. Reduced damage to city streets and alleys by reducing the number of packer trucks to one truck on one route per week;
4. Greater assurance that all households have legal and regular trash pickup and disposal to protect the health and safety of the residents; and
5. Provide for curbside recycling program.

Copies of the Proposal Packet may be obtained in the office of the Department of Public Service. Questions regarding the Proposal Packet should be directed to the same address. There will be a Prebid meeting on Friday, March 8, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. at the City Administration Building. Attendance is voluntary, but suggested.

Proposals must be on the Proposal Forms and in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Each Proposal must be accompanied by a guaranty in the amount of \$5,000 in the form of either a bond, certified or cashier's check, or a money order to provide that if the Proposal is accepted a Contract will be entered into according to the requirements of the Proposal and any applicable provisions of the Ohio Revised Code. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a corporate surety bond issued by a surety licensed to do business in the State of Ohio and acceptable to the City of Circleville for faithful performance during the Contract term.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all Proposals, select any Proposal option, to waive any irregularities and/or informalities in the Proposals, to negotiate with one or more Bidder, and to make an award in any manner deemed, in the City's consideration, to be in the best interest of the people of the City of Circleville. The City also reserves the right to solicit new proposals.
