The following political jurisdictions including Ross County; Pike County; Pickaway County; the City of Chillicothe; and the City of Circleville, collectively designated as Region 17, will apply for a grant from the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) under the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) in the amount of \$1,218,179.00. The NSP was authorized under the Housing and Economic Recovery Act (HERA) of 2008, for the purpose of assisting in the redevelopment of abandoned and foreclosed homes.
